Guidelines

Presentation Options	
Presentation 50 minutes	Most presentations will be offered in this standard form on each day of the conference.
Other Format	The conference committee will consider proposals for other formats, eg panels, short sessions or displays. These should be discussed prior to formal submission.

- While a focus at this conference will be the new senior NSW HSC syllabuses now being implemented in Years 11 and 12, we do not want to ignore junior courses or other areas of professional interest. We welcome proposals on all aspects of the new NSW senior syllabuses, particularly new topic content, assessment, concepts & skills and approaches to programming. We also hope to offer presentations on a range of other topics, including but not limited to: teaching history in the digital age, Indigenous history, innovative pedagogies, leading a department, Elective History and fresh approaches to all areas of NSW junior history courses. This conference will not include sessions on primary history.

- **The closing date for proposals is 9 March 2019.**
- Should a proposal be accepted, the information provided on the proposal form will be used to produce presenter profiles and abstracts in the conference program. Please ensure that this information is accurate and typed in concise prose in a **Word document**.
- All rooms will have PC data projector facilities. Internet access is expected but cannot be guaranteed. Sessions requiring delegates to have access to their own wifi enabled devices will need to have this final sentence in their abstract: 'It is recommended that those attending this session have access to their own wifi enabled device.'
- It may not be possible to accept all proposals. There will be very limited opportunity, for example, for promoting commercial products within the program.
- Presenters will be offered free conference registration on the day they are presenting, with a limit of two free registrations per session when there is more than one presenter. There will be no discounted registration for panel members.
- Proposals for more than one session will be considered.
- Ensure that all contact details remain current prior to the conference. We will rely on prompt email communication and confirmation at a number of stages in the development of the program.
