For the past three years HTANSW has run a program aimed at inducting and mentoring new presenters for our professional development and student lecture days. While a major goal has been to discover and develop new expertise from within HTA member ranks, the program also offers a unique professional learning opportunity that addresses a number of priorities highlighted by the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers. It also might be of interest to those interested in contributing to professional learning after retirement. The program will run again in 2019-2020.

- The 2019-20 program will consist of two components:
 - 1) An induction session (2.5 hours)
 - 2) A practice component offering an opportunity to prepare and present at a HTA event with the support of a mentor
- The induction session is scheduled for 25 November, to run from 4.00 6.30 pm.
- The venue for the Induction Session will be Marsden High School, 22a Winbourne St, West Ryde.
- At the same time, we *may* be able to offer an online version of the induction session for rural members.
- Those who complete the induction session will have the option of registering for the practice component of the program but this will not be mandatory.
- Participation is open to HTANSW members only but places will be limited to a maximum of 15 and registration will only be offered after expressions of interest are considered.
- The program will be endorsed at the Proficient level.
