COMPETITION RULES

- 1 All decisions made by the judges are final. Please keep in mind questions have been written by an independent member of the NSW HTA.
- 2 Smart Watches, iPads and mobile devices are to be in bags during the competition. Any team found with these devices will be disqualified.
- 3 Each school may bring 1 reserve per year group. This reserve can switch from team A to B.
- 4 No notes or coaching is allowed during the competition.
- 5 Any team deemed by judges to be infringing the rules or the spirit of the competition will be disqualified.
- 6 Teams not reaching the semi-finals should be present at the end of the competition. Please keep this in mind – students reaching the finals should still have a crowd to compete in front of.
- 7 All participants and spectators are to observe the necessity for silence during question and answer time.
- 8 In the event of a tied score, a tie-break phase of questions will be asked.
- 9 If a team is composed of Yr 7 & 8 students, the team will be considered a Yr 8 team.
- 10 Students must not change groups during the competition.
- 11 No entries will be taken on the day.
